COPS Funding	Would authorize \$106 million funding for "Cops on the Street"*	Funded in Budget
Court Security Funding	Would authorize \$497.8 million for court security through 2014-15.*	Funded in Budget
Booking Fees	Would authorize \$31 million in reimbursement.*	Funded in Budget
STC Funding	Would authorize \$19.4 million for correctional training.*	Funded in Budget
Cal MMET	Would authorize \$4,500,000 for Meth enforcement*	Funded in Budget
Mentally Ill Crime Reduction (MIOCR) Grants	Would authorize \$40.1 million for crime reduction*	Funded in Budget
